RDC AUTOMOTIVE GROUP LIMITED T/A LORDES (“LORDES”) takes your privacy very seriously. We ask that you read this privacy policy carefully as it contains important information about what to expect when LORDES collects personal information about you and how LORDES will use your personal data.

This policy applies to information we collect about:

1. visitors to our website;
2. people who are our clients or who register for our services prior to becoming customers;
3. our agents and subcontractors; and
4. applicants for jobs with us.

1 The information we collect about you

We collect the following personal information from you:

- 1.1 name;
- 1.2 postal address, email address, telephone number, credit card number and expiry date; and
- 1.3 details of your car.

Occasionally we may receive information about you from other sources (such as credit reference agencies) which we will add to the information which we already hold about you in order to help us improve the service we provide.

2 How we will use the information about you

We gather this information to allow us to process your registration, action any orders you may make, and any other actions we may need to take in order to provide you with the service(s) you require. The relevant information is then used by us, our agents and sub-contractors to provide you with statements of your account and to communicate with you on any matter relating to the conduct of your account and the provision of the services in general. We may also contact you about other products and services we think may be of interest to you.

We may also use aggregate information and statistics for the purposes of monitoring website usage in order to help us to develop our website and our services. We may also provide such aggregate information to third parties. These statistics will not include information that can be used to identify you.

From time to time we may provide your information to our customer service agencies for research and analysis purposes so that we can monitor and improve the services we provide. We or our agents and sub-contractors may contact you by post, email or telephone to ask you for your feedback and comments on our services.

3 Marketing

We may also wish to provide you with information about special features of services which we think may be of interest to you. If you would rather not receive this information, please send a blank email message to *Robert.paterson@lordes.co.uk* If you agree to us providing you with marketing information, you can always opt out at a later date.

We may also want to provide you with related information from third parties we think may be of interest to you. If you would rather not receive this information, please send an email to *Greg.larking@lordes.co.uk* If you agree to us providing you with third party marketing information, you can always opt out at a later date.

We may also provide your information to carefully selected third parties whose products or services we believe may be of interest to you. If you do not wish us to disclose your information in this way, please send an email to [*Robert.paterson@lordes.co.uk*].

4 Our use of cookies and other information-gathering technologies

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behaviour information. The information is used to track visitor use of the website and to compile statistical reports on website activity. accept cookies and the above websites tell you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases some of our website features may not function if you remove cookies from your browser.

5 How we protect your information
